




Impact Report 2018

On **April 4, 2018**, the University of Texas at El Paso welcomed **38** organizations with local opportunities to hire students in either internship or part-time positions. The intention is to promote better awareness among students of opportunities in the area, where they can gain experience and enhance their future employability upon graduation.

There were **489** recorded student attendees, **3 El Paso Community College**, **30 Alumni + community members**. In a survey given to **353** of the students, we found that it was attended by all Colleges: Business Administration-**16.33%**, Education-**2.33%**, Engineering - **36.15%**, Liberal Arts **20.41%**, Science – **16.91%** Health Sciences – **4.37%**, and Nursing - **3.70%**.

94% would recommend the fair to other students

95% stated, they found it a moderately useful to extremely useful experience (see graph below).
