


Graduate & Professional Schools Fair 2022 In-person Impact Report


Impact Report: In-person

On Tuesday, October 4, 2022, The University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) welcomed recruiters from 62 graduate programs to our in-person event. This effort exposed students to various options for post-Baccalaureate study. These included the Colleges of Business Administration, Education, Engineering, Health Sciences, Liberal Arts, Educational Leadership and Foundations Program and the Graduate School. We strove to serve students with programs from health & related programs, law, in addition to general graduate-level study options. The following is the profile breakdown of the 321 attendees. 
IN-PERSON STUDENT PROFILES: N-321



Student Evaluation Responses


In a survey requested to fair participants, 97 responded in the following way.

93.75%


of students would agree to strongly agree in recommending the fair to other students.

of students found the fair at least moderately to extremely useful in their graduate program search





Recruiter Evaluation Responses


In a survey given to all recruiters, 39 responded in the following way.
