EMBA Features

Unique characteristics designed specifically for the EMBA:

- Courses are offered every other week (twice monthly) all day Friday and Saturday, with two courses completed every five sessions.
- Students engage the MBA coursework with peers who have similar management and business leadership experience.
- An International Research Course is conducted over a week-long international field study.
- Classes are held at the UTEP Graduate Business Center in Downtown El Paso.
- Each EMBA cohort is kept purposefully small to maximize meaningful discourse and networking.
- The curriculum consists of a 48 credit hour program that includes 33 credit hours of MBA core courses and 15 credit hours of specially designed EMBA electives.
- Students who successfully complete the program earn a Master of Business Administration degree.

Admission to the Executive MBA Program

Applicants must submit the following to be considered for admission to the EMBA program:

- Online Application for Admission (available at mba.utep.edu).
- Official transcript from an accredited institution demonstrating completion of a four-year Bachelor's degree (or equivalent in the case of an international institution) and official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended. Official transcripts for degrees earned at UTEP are not required.
- Statement of Purpose, not to exceed one page.
- Résumé.
- Two letters of reference from professional and/or academic sources (One letter of support from current employer required).
- Applicants must demonstrate at least 5 years of managerial experience. Employer references required.
- International applicants whose undergraduate degree was delivered in a language other than English are required to submit TOEFL scores of at least 250/600.
- Applicants will be interviewed by MBA Program staff as part of the evaluation process.

EMBA Program

The 2017 Executive MBA Program cost is \$45,000. Program cost includes:

- Tuition & registration fees.
- iPad Pro, digital textbooks, case materials, and software.
- International Research Course lodging, ground transportation and some meals (excludes airfare).
- Access to online Quantitative skills course.
- Individualized Executive Coaching.

Tuition, fees, and charges are subject to change without previous notice by administrative, legislative, or regent action. Changes become effective on the date enacted.

Financial Aid

The University of Texas at El Paso has a Financial Aid Office that will assist you with your financial aid application. For more information, call (915) 747-6536.

- Federal loans may cover your program cost.
- You may qualify for a Stafford loan regardless of your current employment or credit history.
- Loan repayment starts six months after you earn your degree.
- Many companies offer full or partial tuition reimbursement for their employees. Check with your human resources department to determine what kind of education benefits are available.
- Military education benefits available through the GI Bill may be applicable.
