The curriculum change requested is for the following: We want to collapse the four separate minors we presently have into just one minor. The reason for this change is that we want to remove the obstacles created for students when they are forced to choose from one of four specific minor options. If a course in one of the four specific minors is not offered, this impedes students from completing their degrees on time. By having one minor only, this ensures that students will always have courses to choose from and will be able to complete their degrees in a timely manner. We want our students to have the freedom to choose 18 hours from an interdisciplinary curriculum that covers courses from all of the previous four minors and to graduate without scheduling impediments.




