Internship & Part-Time Job Fair - Impact Report 2023

On March 30, 2023, The University of Texas at El Paso welcomed 55 local organizations to the Internship and Part-Time Job Fair. The intention of this event is to promote better awareness among students of opportunities in the area, where they can gain experience and enhance their future employability upon graduation.

There were 632 total attendees, (620 UTEP students, 5 Alumni and 7 community members). From the 625 active captured participants in Job Mine, below is the breakdown per college.




1. Overall, how beneficial do you think this career fair was to your job search process?

Student Responses (N =98)




1. Rate the level preparedness of UTEP students


Employer Responses (N = 38)
