Semester GPA (Semester: _____)

1. List all of your classes in the left column of the table below (do not include developmental courses)
2. Enter the letter grade you earned (or anticipate to earn)
3. List the number of credit hours the course is worth (usually 3-5, and labs are usually worth 1)
4. List the Grade Point value found in the small table
5. Multiply the Credit Hour by the Grade Point Value to find the Quality Points
6. Add up the total number of credit hours taken for the semester (DO NOT include developmental courses*)
7. Add up the total number of the Quality Points earned
8. Divide the **total quality points** by the **total credit hours**

GPA Calculation Notes

- ❖ To view an Overall GPA, go to Goldmine and click on "Student Records," "Academic Transcript," and "submit." Scroll to the bottom and look for "Transcript Totals."
- ❖ To calculate an overall GPA by hand, divide TOTAL QUALITY POINTS by TOTAL CREDIT HOURS to get OVERALL GPA.
- ❖ Grades of S, U, I, P, W, WC, N, and CR are excluded from GPA calculations
- ❖ Developmental Courses (courses that start with a '0') and transfer credit grades are excluded from GPA calculations
