Perennial	<i>Zephyranthes candida</i>	White Rain Lily	1 gal	Native to Central and South America, this little bulb forms a clump of narrow, glossy, dark green leaves. In the summer and early fall, it is covered with waxy white flowers. Flowers small, purple to dark blue with yellow stamens extending beyond the single petal, crowded in narrow, 3-6 in., spikelike clusters at or near the ends of the branchlets, appearing from April to June. Although known to originate from a dry tropical biome, its adaptability to various soil types and climates ensures its versatility. It thrives in both full sun and partial shade, making it a versatile choice for landscapes across a wide range of regions. In spring and throughout the summer months, Justicia spicigera 'Veracruz' bursts into bloom with an abundance of tubular orange flowers arranged in showy clusters.
