Excellent fresh, roasted, sautéed or stuffed.	Verdura	Ésta variedad produce unos dulces y jugosos pimientos de 3-4" que varían de verde oscuro a rojo. Grass	<i>Bouteloua curtipendula</i>	Side Oats Grama	1 gal	Side Oats Grama is a drought-tolerant clumping grass with bluish green leaf blades and unusual flowering stems. Seed spikes hang on just one side of the flowering stem, resembling oats as they dry and turn brown. Foliage turns a warm golden brown in the fall, and the lower foliage may turn shades of red or purple. Thriving in full sun, 'Mexicali Rose' achieves its best floral display when exposed to abundant sunlight for at least six hours per day. Although known to originate from a dry tropical biome, its adaptability to various soil types and climates ensures its versatility. It thrives in both full sun and partial shade, making it a versatile choice for landscapes across a wide range of regions. In spring and throughout the summer months, <i>Justicia spicigera</i> 'Veracruz' bursts into bloom with an abundance of tubular orange flowers arranged in showy clusters. These vibrant blossoms attract hummingbirds and butterflies, adding movement and life to the garden.	Arbusto	
Shrub	<i>Larrea tridentata</i>	Creosote Bush	5 gal	This tough evergreen shrub is especially aromatic after a rain. In the wild it has an open form with sparse olive green foliage on woody stems.
