

Dr. Osama Mikhail was appointed in 2016 as the interim dean of the UTEP College of Health Sciences while simultaneously serving as the senior vice president for strategic planning at the UT Health Science Center at Houston, a position he held beginning in 2007. In 2017, following the appointment of Dr. Shafik Dharamsi as the dean of the College of Health Sciences, Mikhail served as the interim chair of the Department of Kinesiology, a position he held until January 2021. Prior to his administrative appointments, Mikhail was a professor of management and policy at the UT Houston School of Public Health and also served as the school's interim dean.

Mikhail received a BS in math/physics from the American University of Beirut in Lebanon, an MBA in finance from the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School, and an MS and PhD in industrial administration/systems sciences from the Graduate School of Industrial Administration at Carnegie-Mellon University in Pittsburgh.
