Instructions: Student should identify which pre-requisite courses have been completed or anticipated term of completion along with the college or university, hours earned, or anticipated, term, and assigned grade. For the grade value column, enter the numerical value your university assigns to a letter grade. Most universities calculate 4 points for an A, 3 points for a B, 2 points for a C, 1 point for a D and 0 for an F. However, if your university uses +/-, then the points may vary and not all universities use a 4.0 grade scale. Look at the final page of your transcript for the numerical value to enter in the quality points column. The file will then automatically calculate your pre-requisite GPA if entered correctly.

UTEP admissions committee will review transcripts only after OTCAS verification and payment of the UTEP application fee.
