**BS-RHSC Academic Requirements**

- RHSC majors must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade-point average (CGPA) to be in good standing in the program.
- Students must graduate with a minimum 3.0 CGPA to earn the RHSC degree.
- Failure to meet the minimum CGPA will result in an Academic Warning (AW). After the AW, the CGPA must be raised to a 3.00 by the conclusion of the next 12 semester hours. If the 3.0 is not achieved by the conclusion of the AW period, student is dismissed from the RHSC major and must select another major.
- Students who receive one D, one F, or more than two C grades in DRSC courses will be dismissed from the RHSC major and must select another major.

12 of the last 30 semester hours must be completed at UTEP.

12 hours of advanced courses must be completed within 3 years of graduation date.

The minimum UTEP cumulative grade point average to earn a bachelors degree is 2.0.

Note: The BS-RHSC degree requires a 3.0 cumulative grade point average to graduate.

A maximum of 66 semester hours of credit from two-year institutions is applicable toward a degree at UTEP.
