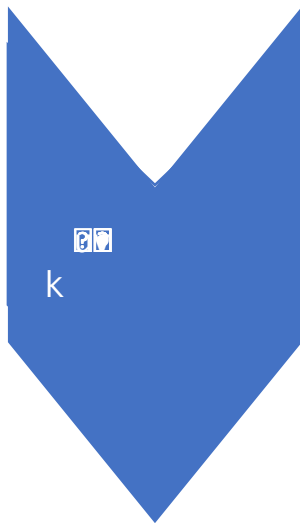
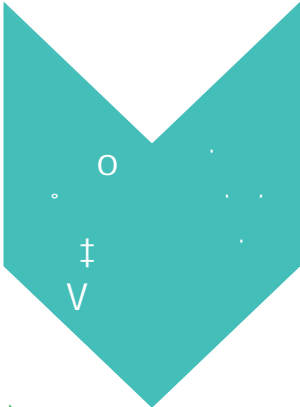


EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAM (EPP)

Admission Requirements & Process



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- An email is sent out to the student to attend a workshop to
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- The workshop takes approximately 1.5 hours and covers field based experience, testing requirements, timeline for testing, test preparation resources, student teaching, and set up Texas Education Agency (TEA) account
- Students sign EPP Acceptance Agreement; Acceptance Letter issued to students; Student officially admitted into the EPP with the TEA.
- \$35 TEA technology fee charged to student's account.
- For BA-ALD and Liberal Arts students, their pre-minor code is removed.
- Students are given access to enroll in EPP coursework.



- Student prepare and take Content, Pedagogy and Professional responsibilities (PP) and other relevant Qualifying Exam. Student must score 78% to get clearance for TExES tests.
