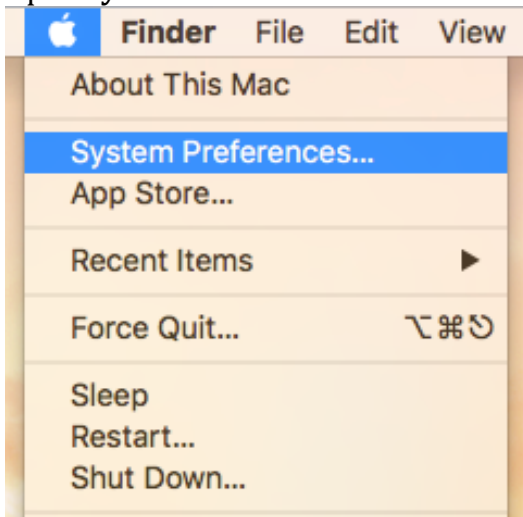
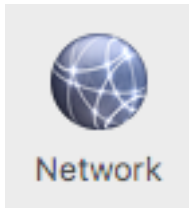


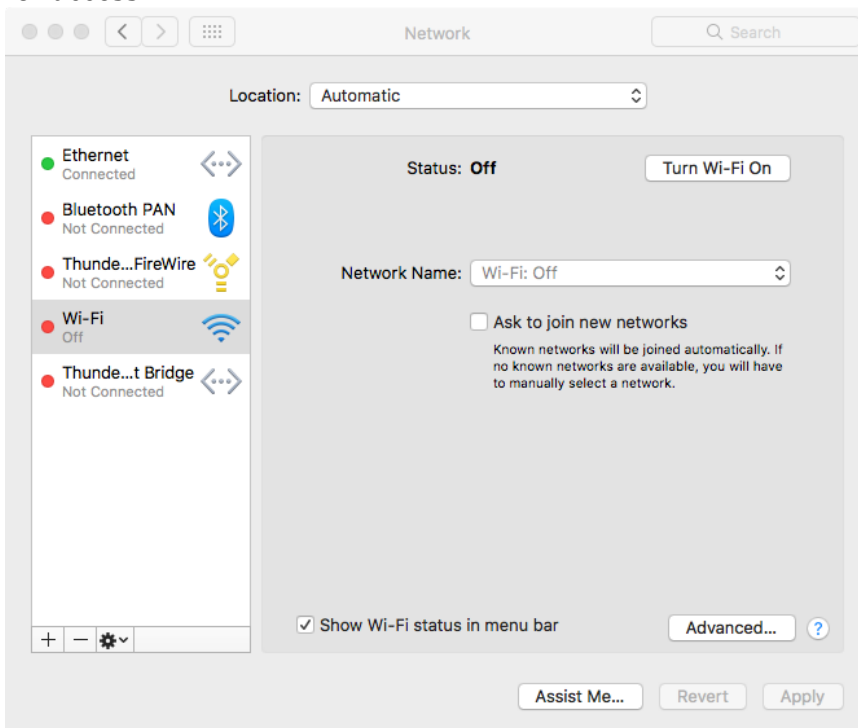
Open System Preferences


