Ideal candidates:

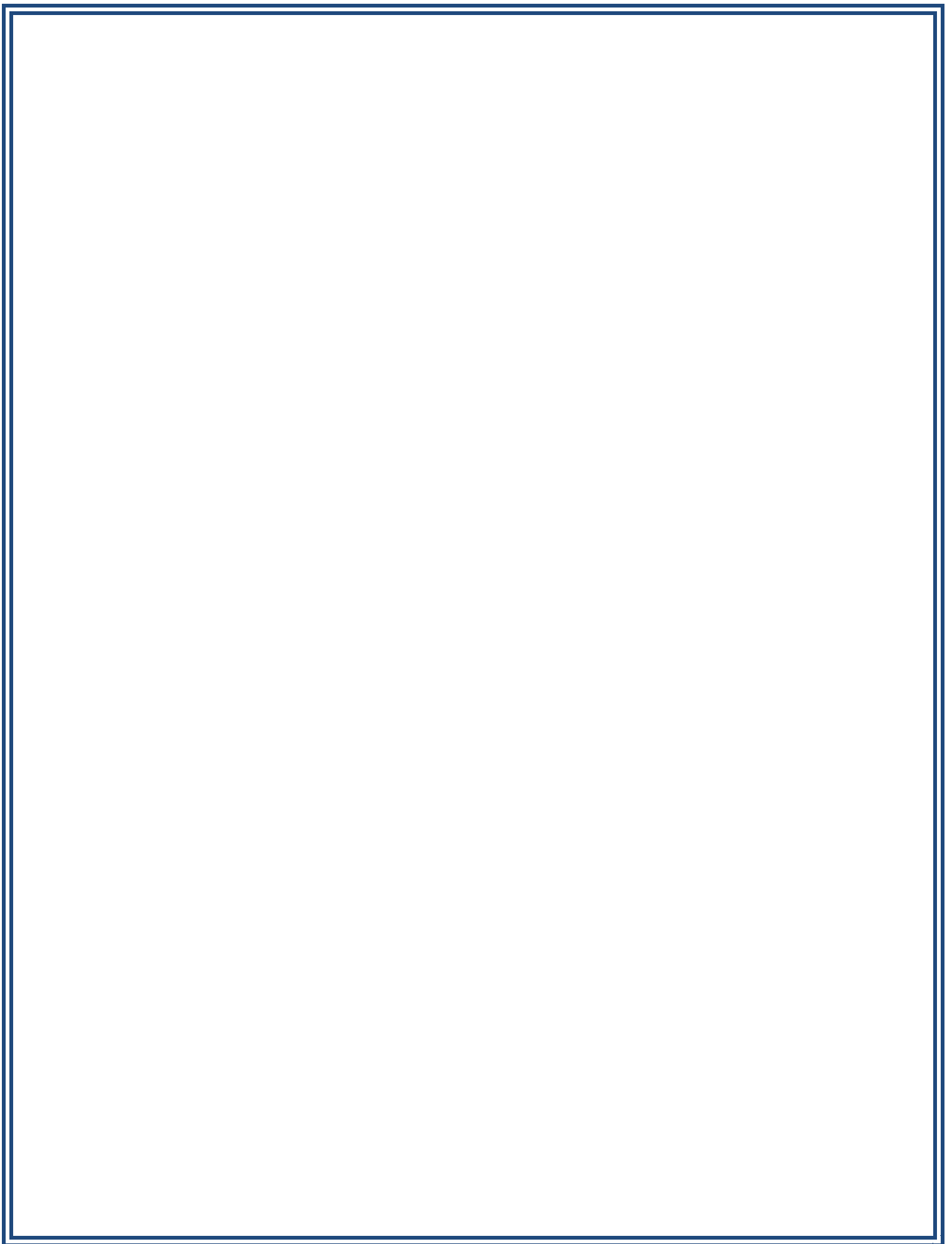
- Have an interest in a project-based internship learning more about Department of Defense (DoD) testing needs, resources and capabilities.
