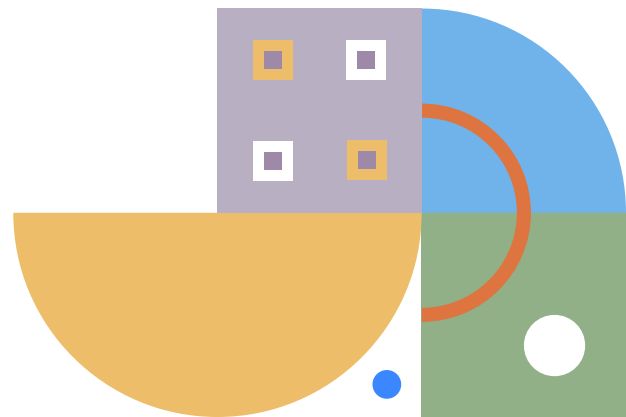
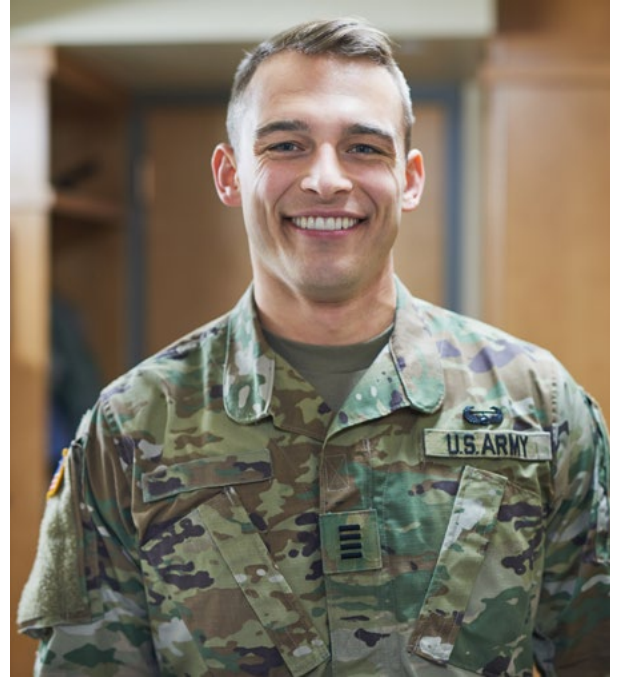
Your Fall 2026 Course Guide to Military Career Assistance

How to Register

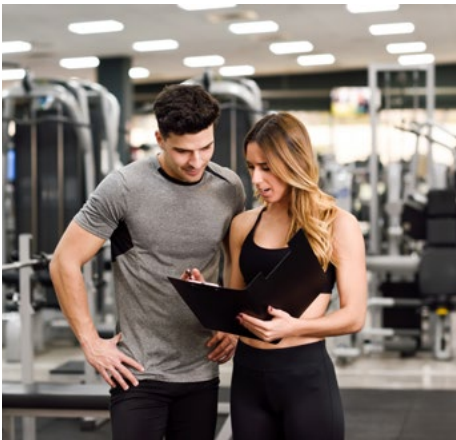

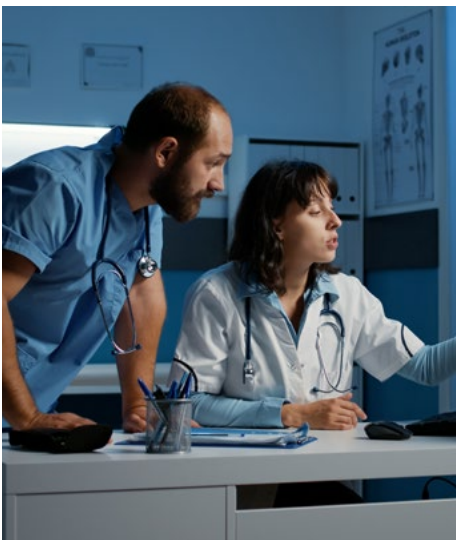

MYCAA

Clinical Medical Assistant Certification Program With Externship

The Clinical Medical Assisting online certification course from University of Texas at El Paso is designed to prepare students to function as professionals in multiple healthcare settings. Medical assistants with a clinical background perform various clinical tasks including assisting with the administration of medications and with minor procedures, performing an EKG electrocardiogram, obtaining laboratory specimens for testing, educating patients, and other related tasks. Job opportunities are prevalent with physicians' offices, clinics, chiropractors' offices, hospitals and outpatient facilities.

Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts Program (MyCAA)

Professional and Public Programs accepts MyCAA funding for approved training certification courses in a variety of areas.



Army Credentialing Assistance Program

The Army Credentialing Assistance (CA) Program provides financial assistance for soldiers to earn professional and technical credentials. Professional and Public Programs is an approved ArmyIgnitEDeducational provider.

***Note that we do not provide the actual funding;** however, we provide the Education Training Plan (ETP) for MyCAA and the quote for the Army Credentialing.

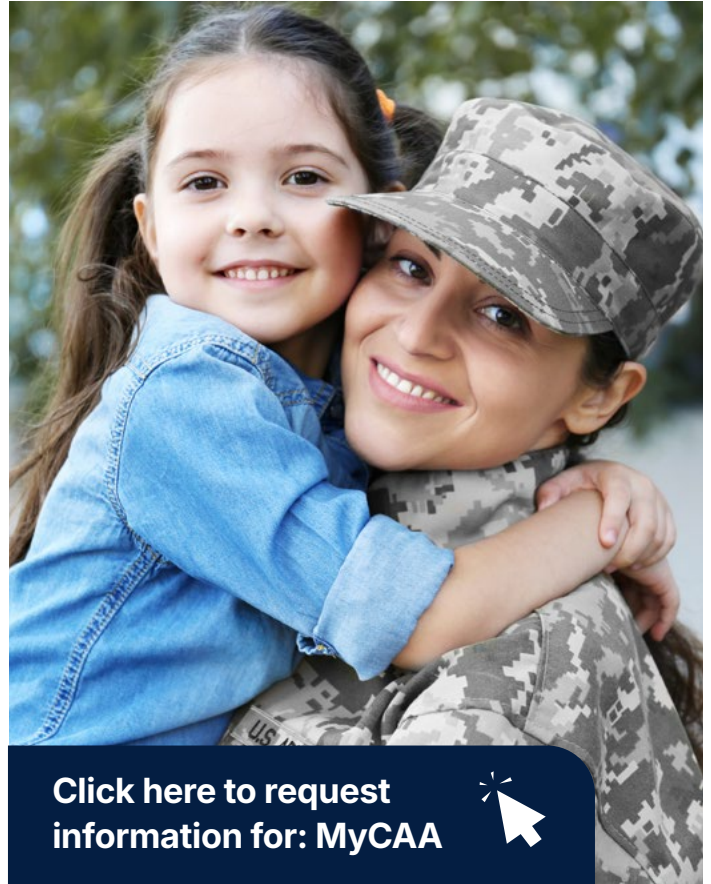
My CAA

UTEP's Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts Program (MyCAA) provides financial assistance and a career path for military spouses. Professional and Public Programs at UTEP is a proud participant in this program.

We are grateful for the sacrifice and courage of our men and women in the armed forces. Because we understand the strain that this can have on families who have a spouse on active duty, we want to help.

What is MyCAA?

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship provides a maximum tuition benefit of \$4,000 with an annual fiscal year cap of \$2,000 to assist eligible military spouses who need professional credentials to meet their career goals. Annual cap waivers may be available if costs exceed \$2,000, up to the maximum education benefit of \$4,000.

5 Easy Steps to Get you Started

1. Visit the [MyCAA website](#) to set up a personal profile and verify your MyCAA eligibility.
2. Request your Education Training Plan (ETP) by clicking the blue button above.
3. Upload your ETP. If you have issues with this, contact MyCAA for assistance.
4. Get approved. When UTEP MWCA receives your Financial Assistance (FA) letter, we will enroll you in the course on the start date of your choice.
5. Start your studies. UTEP MWCA will email course instructions.

Army Credentialing Assistance Program

Professional and Public Programs is an approved ArmyIgnitED educational provider. The Army Credentialing Assistance (CA) Program allows soldiers to earn professional and technical credentials.

The CA program is similar to the Army's existing tuition assistance program and provides financial assistance for soldiers to pursue and earn credentials leading to an industry-recognized academic or vocational credential. These credentials do not have to be linked to the soldier's Military Occupational Specialty (MOS).

This is a voluntary, off-duty training and education program that directly contributes to improving total army readiness, supporting soldiers' professional development, retaining quality soldiers and preparing soldiers for meaningful employment upon transition from military service.

What is paid for?

Credentialing Assistance will pay for all necessary books, supplies and associated materials required for an approved training course and/or exam that shall not exceed \$4,000.

Who is eligible for Army Credentialing Assistance?

As of January 2020, the Army Credentialing Assistance Program is available at bases nationwide.

- Soldiers must meet basic Federal TA eligibility requirements
- Soldiers cannot be flagged under provisions of AR 600-8-2
- Soldiers cannot be contracted ROTC scholarship cadets (receiving tuition and fees or room and board) or Green to Gold ROTC program cadets
- Soldiers must have enough time remaining in service to complete the credential before separating from the Army

5 Steps to Get you Started

1. Choose your course. Choose your credentialing course from the [ArmyIgnitED webpage](#) or by browsing our online courses.
2. Request your quote. After choosing your course or exam, click on the 'Request Quote' button and complete the form.
3. Upload your quote. UTEP MWCA will contact you by email with the quote for your course, and will submit an invoice through ArmyIgnitED for approval of your Financial Assistance (FA).
4. Wait for approval. You and UTEP MWCA will be notified by ArmyCAP once the Financial Assistance (FA) documents have been approved.
5. Start learning. Once funding is approved, UTEP MWCA will register you and email course instructions.
