

1. Contact us.

2. Choose your course.

While applying for your grant, explore eligible Professional and Public Programs courses at the **Workforce Innovations Career Assistance web page**.

3. Request an acceptance or bid letter.

Your WIOA Counselor will need an acceptance or bid letter for the course you choose with Professional and Public Programs.

4. Get approved.

In most cases, your WIOA counselor will notify you if your training plan and funding are approved. You may receive a voucher, authorization letter or purchase order document, depending on the funding. Please send that approval document to **p3mwca@utep.edu.**

5. Start learning.

After we receive confirmation that your funding is approved, we will register you for the approved program. You will receive a welcome email prior to your start date with instructions on how to begin the course.
