- To take on leadership roles in their campuses/districts.

- Develop, implement, and assess literacy curriculum and professional development in literacy
- Apply your knowledge across diverse learners/learners with diverse needs

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Students in this concentration must have Texas teaching certification, at least three years of PK-12 teaching experience, and must complete the following requirements:

- Apply for admission to the M.Ed. in Literacy and Learning Science with a Concentration in Texas Reading Specialist
- Submit a second application for admission into the Texas Reading Specialist program through UTEP
- Complete a 160-hour, supervised practicum as part of RED 5349
