FAST TRACK COMBINED BS/MBA PROGRAM BS IN ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING Student Advising Form

Application Requirements:

The Fast Track Combined BS/MBA Program enables outstanding undergraduate UTEP students majoring in Engineering to receive dual undergraduate and graduate credit for up to 18 hours of UTEP graduate coursework towards BS degrees in Computer Science, Electrical Engineering or Industrial Engineering and MBA degree requirements as determined by the College of Engineering and the College of Business Administration. Eligible students must:

- Have successfully completed at least 90 hours of undergraduate coursework toward their degree.
- Have and maintain a minimum 3.30 undergraduate GPA.
- Be admitted to the Full-Time MBA Program.

Complete the form below and submit it to the Graduate School after provisional admission into the Full-Time MBA Program. The Graduate School will process the enrollment. Notes:

1. Students must be advised each semester at the departmental level by both the undergraduate and graduate advisors and cleared for registration in graduate courses by the Graduate School.
2. Students must earn a B or better in graduate courses. The earned grade will first appear on the undergraduate transcript. Upon full admission into the Graduate School, the earned credit will appear on the graduate transcript.
3. Tuition will be based on the level of the course, not the level of the student. Financial aid may be adjusted.
4. Exceptions to these guidelines will be handled through an appeal process established by the participating graduate program.
5. Courses must be approved for dual credit by the Curriculum and Graduate Council Committees.
