Proposal Title: Changes to Music History in the Bachelor of Music degree

Currently, all music majors are required to take MUSL 3321 and 3322, Classical Music History I and II, formerly Music History Survey I and II.¹ In the previous century, when people with a music degree could make a career out of performing with a symphony orchestra and teaching at a music conservatory, that was a good plan. In the 21st century, musicians are finding new and exciting ways to make a career in music. Learning different types of nonclassical music is now equally as important as learning classical music.

The purpose of this proposal is to allow music majors to take a combination of classical and nonclassical music. This will better prepare our graduates for a career in music in the 21st century.
