#### Proposal Title: French Minor Course Requirement Change

Due to a recent decrease in enrollment in upper-division French courses, and to help increase the number of students minoring in French, we propose the following changes to the French minor program:

- 1. Allow FREN 1301 and FREN 1302 to count towards the minor
- 2. Change the minor electives (any level) requirements from 6 to 9 credit hours
- 3. Change the minor upper-division requirement from 12 to 9 credit hours
- 4. Allow FREN 1301 and FREN 1302 to double fulfill the foreign language requirement and the minor electives
