Subject: New Prerequisite Options for Hist. 1301 and Hist. 1302

The history department would like to create additional options for meeting the prerequisite requirements for our first year surveys, Hist. 1301 and Hist. 1302. We would like to add the following courses to the present list of ways in which students can qualify to enter these courses: HIST 1301 (as prerequisite for HIST 1302), HIST 1302 (as prerequisite for HIST 1301), POLS 2310, POLS 2311, PSYC 1301, and SOCI 1301. We believe that all of these entry level classes would sufficiently demonstrate the necessary reading and writing skills for our first year classes. Establishing them as prerequisites will make the work of the Advising Center easier and, in some cases, simply make the system more rational (obviously, from our point of view, having passed HIST 1301 would suggest readiness for HIST 1302, and the fact that that is sometimes a stumbling block at present is ridiculous).
