Currently, SCED 3311 (Curriculum Planning in the Secondary School) is a prerequisite for HIST 4330 (Teaching History/Social Studies). However, the College of Education is now requiring History majors who are training to become teachers to complete most or all major coursework before taking courses in the minor, including SCED 3311. Furthermore, Brad Cartwright, the regular instructor for HIST 4330, sees no need for students to take SCED 3311 before HIST 4330. Therefore, the Department would like to remove that prerequisite.
