Proposal Title: INSS Certificate Increase in Credit Hours

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We propose increasing each of the two INSS certificate programs by an additional three credits, by adding an elective course. It will, first, deepen their course work in the field and, second, raise each of the certificates to 18 credit hours, making them eligible for financial aid.
