Proposal Title: Change to Latin American and Border Studies minor

We propose to update the Latin American Border Studies minor requirement of LABS 3300 so students instead have the option of LABS 3300 or 3301. Currently LABS 3300 is required; there is not an option. LABS 3300 is « The Americas » (covering Latin America) and LABS 3301 is « The Border ». Both of them provide fundamental information in the minor. There is no reason LABS 3300 would be more required than LABS 3301, and requiring both courses would increase the difficulty of completing the minor. That would be contrary to the goals of UTEP. The next best solution is to allow students to choose at least one as their required course (they can take both, of course—the other as an elective). This would give students more flexibility in the minor and take better advantage of LABS 3301, which is regularly offered.
