Proposal Title: Remove Border Politics as a subfield in the MA POLS degree plan

The requested change will remove "Border Politics" as a subfield in the MA in Political Science degree plan and change course requirement language to reflect this change. We are doing this because two of our courses, POLS 5336: Seminar in Southwest Border Politics and POLS 5344: Seminar in Border Theory, have been deactivated. The remaining class, POLS 5343: Seminar in Border Politics, will count as general credit with the elimination of the Border Politics subfield. This change to consolidate these courses into one will eliminate the significant overlaps in the content across the three border seminars. Furthermore, with recent retirements, the Department of Political Science and Public Administration no longer has sufficient faculty with expertise in Border Politics to sustain the graduate concentration and its three courses.
