Proposal Title: Spanish Major Foreign Language Requirement

Recently the number of Spanish majors has decreased, from 70 to 24 majors from 2018 to 2022. We are proposing the following changes to increase the number of students majoring in this program.

1. Allow Spanish majors to choose Spanish as their Foreign language

- 2 Change the 'Upper division requirement' from 6 to 3 credits (see attached document 'Spanish major catalog')
- 3. Change the 'Electives' (any level) from 6 to 9 credits (see attached document 'Spanish major catalog')
- 4. Allow Spanish language classes to double fulfill the foreign language requirement AND the 'Electives' (any level) major requirement simultaneously (see note a. below or attached document 'Spanish major catalog')
- 5. Make an exception for Spanish majors and allow up to 9 credit hours, not 6, of Spanish language credits to double fulfill the foreign language requirement and the major electives (see note b. below or attached document 'Spanish major catalog')

Two notes were added to the 'Spanish major catalog' document:

a. One Up to two (2) Spanish courses taken to complete the foreign language requirement can be used to fulfill this section of the Spanish major, however, the hours will only count once towards the degree's credit hour requirement.

OR, if an exception is approved

b. Up to three (3) lower division Spanish courses taken to complete the foreign language requirement can be used to fulfill this section of the Spanish major, however, the hours will only count once towards the degree's credit hour requirement.
