You are invited to apply for the Hispanic Serving Institutions-Pathways to the Professoriate program (HSI-Pathways) at The University of Texas at El Paso. The HSI-Pathways program prepares undergraduate students in the humanities and related fields to pursue a career in the professoriate through engaged mentorship and programming, as well as opportunities to participate in research. Students must be majoring in one of the Mellon Foundation's approved majors listed below and should demonstrate the potential and desire to pursue a Ph.D. with the intention of entering the professoriate. All UTEP students in eligible majors and who are broadly classified as "juniors" (with an anticipated graduation date of Spring 2020) are welcome to apply.
