HOW IT WORKS

Membership in the LAHP offers a supplemental minor that is not intended to replace your chosen minor or require any additional classes. Instead, the courses needed to complete the 18-credit hour LAHP Minor are courses that fit within your degree plan - in your major, minor, or block elective requirements. We have a list of over 100 honors-designed courses!

Members must also enroll in two Theory and Methodology courses that are restricted to LAHP students only. These courses range in topic each semester and are taught by different professors.

Towards the end of your undergraduate degree, students must complete an honors project/thesis and present it during our LAHP Symposium. Students will select a faculty mentor and work on a project of their choosing. Projects must be related to the students' field of study.
