  - → indigenous peoples
  - → social services for diverse populations
- → many other applications of concept of "culture" to business, personnel relations, etc.
- (2) Certificate in Cultural Heritage Management
- \* 12 required credits (3-4 courses) taken as part of major or minor in anthropology
- \* Prepares students for careers in archeology and museums
- → many jobs are available in contract archeology in this and other regions of the U.S.
- → museum professionals, including public outreach, displays, and curation
- → cultural heritage with indigenous and immigrant communities
