

## CAREERS IN APPLIED ANTHROPOLOGY

### (1) Certificate in Applied Cultural Anthropology

\* 12 required credits (4 courses) taken as part of major or minor in anthropology

\* Prepares students for careers with government agencies, businesses, and community organizations working with culturally distinctive populations

→ immigrants; non-English speaking groups

→ indigenous peoples

→ social services for diverse populations

→ many other applications of concept of “culture” to business, personnel relations, etc.

### (2) Certificate in Cultural Heritage Management

\* 12 required credits (3-4 courses) taken as part of major or minor in anthropology

\* Prepares students for careers in archeology and museums

→ many jobs are available in contract archeology in this and other regions of the U.S.

→ museum professionals, including public outreach, displays, and curation

→ cultural heritage with indigenous and immigrant communities
