

2017 MAYMESTER PROGRAM IN SEVILLE, SPAIN

MAY 21—JUNE 8, 2017

A comprehensive program including classroom use at the Center for Cross-Cultural Study for academic study, bilingual on-site support, local cultural visits and activities, and accommodations in Seville. Students have the opportunity to immerse themselves into the Spanish culture.



ACADEMIC PROGRAM AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

- Orientation in Seville includes airport reception and info sessions with Spanish Studies Abroad staff
- Spanish Studies Abroad professor to teach a series of classes on *Cultura Gastronómica Española* (10 two-hour classes, 20 hours total)
- Local study visits in Seville including entrance fees, accompaniment and guided tours in English by specialized Spanish Studies Abroad professor: walking tour of City Center, Royal Palace, Jewish Quarter, Cathedral, and cooking demo with Triana market visit
- Day excursion to Córdoba including entrance fees, accompaniment and guided tours in English by specialized Spanish Studies Abroad professor: Royal Palace, Synagogue/Jewish Quarter and Mosque-Cathedral
- Day excursion to Cádiz including entrance fees, accompaniment and guided tours in English by specialized Spanish Studies Abroad professor
- Overnight study trip to Granada including entrance fees, accompaniment and guided tours in English by specialized Spanish Studies Abroad professor: Albayzín, Alhambra Palace and Generalife gardens, Royal Chapel and Cathedral
- Two-night study trip to Madrid including entrance fee, accompaniment and guided tour in English by specialized Spanish Studies Abroad professor of Museo del Prado as well as day trip to Toledo

ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEALS

- Fifteen (15) nights lodging in rooms of up to six people at a hostel, with kitchen, in Seville
- One (1) night lodging in rooms of up to four people at a hotel in Granada (Hotel Los Ángeles or similar)
- Two (2) nights lodging in rooms of up to four people at a hotel in Madrid (Hotel H10 Puerta de Alcalá or similar)
- All breakfasts and dinners provided throughout program at hostels, including Welcome Tapas and Farewell Dinner; lunches on own

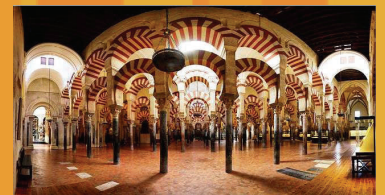
TRANSPORTATION

- One-way AVE tickets to Madrid at the end of program
