Biography

Southwest historian and civic leader Cleofás Calleros was born in Río Florido, Chihuahua, Mexico on April 9, 1896, to Ismael Calleros and Refugio Perales de Calleros. The family immigrated to El Paso, Texas, in 1902, when he was six years old. After graduating from school Calleros worked as a freight clerk for the Santa Fe Railroad, as an accountant and private businessman, and as a social worker and immigration specialist for the Catholic Church, becoming prominent in the civic and religious community in El Paso. In numerous publications, articles, and speeches, he chronicled the history of the Southwestern United States, Mexico and the Catholic Church.

Calleros attended St. Ignatius School and graduated as valedictorian of Sacred Heart School in 1911. The Palmer Business Writing School awarded him a teacher's certificate in 1911, and he attended Draughon's Business College in 1912. He received certificates in law and interstate commerce from LaSalle Extension University in 1920 and in boys' guidance from St. Edward's University

in 1924. New Mexico State University awarded him an honorary Master of Fine Arts degree in 1960, and he later received an honorary doctorate.

Cleofás Calleros married the former Benita Blanco in 1918. Benita was born in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, Mexico, on February 22, 1895, and came to the United States in 1905. She became a United States citizen in 1918. She worked as a stenographer and assisted Calleros in his various business pursuits after their marriage. They had one daughter, Margarita Calleros Blanco, born in 1926.

In his early days in El Paso, Calleros worked after school in various local businesses. While working for a print shop, he learned to print and bind books. In 1912, he started as a messenger boy with the Santa Fe Railway and worked his way up to Chief Line Clerk by 1926. His work with the railroad was interrupted by World War I, when the U. S. Army drafted him in 1917. He became a naturalized U.S. citizen at Camp Travis in San Antonio, Texas, in 1918. As a quartermaster sergeant with Company E, 315th Supply Train, 90th Division, he took part in the St. Mihiel and Meuse Argonne battles in France, where he received the Purple Heart for being wounded in action. He served in the occupation of Germany from 1918 to 1919. After the war Calleros served in the Officers' Reserve Corps from 1920 to 1938.

In 1926 Calleros became the Mexican Border Representative of the National Catholic Welfare Conference's Bureau of Immigration in El Paso. From 1926 until his retirement in 1968, he handled over a million immigration cases in his role as welfare director and social worker, including assisting religious groups who were persecuted and expelled by the Mexican government in the 1930s. For over fifty years, he taught free citizenship classes to immigrants. At times during those years, he served as secretary and assistant to the Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of El Paso, supervising the construction of the Mt. Cristo Rey monument and serving on the boards of various Catholic schools and orphanages.

In addition to his jobs with the railroad and the Catholic Church, Calleros was in business for himself as a notary public and accountant. He managed and owned real estate and engaged in various businesses. He assisted clients with mortgages and loans, immigration and naturalization problems, bookkeeping, and income taxes.

He published over fifteen books and pamphlets in both English and Spanish including regional histories and histories of civic and religious groups in El Paso. He wrote about the Tigua Indians, the Chamizal area, and Southwestern missions and churches. During the 1950s, he wrote a weekly local history column for The El Paso Times, called "El Paso—Then and Now," which was later published in book form. His most famous work, *Historia del Templo de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe*, co-authored with Dr. Angel Alcázar de Velasco, was hand printed and bound in luxurious materials. El Paso artist José Cisneros illustrated the book. The numbered, limited editions were sent to national

libraries, museums, and universities throughout the world. Copies of the unique book were also presented to President John F. Kennedy, Vice-President Johnson, and to Pope John XXIII.

Calleros was a respected and popular speaker who was invited to address many civic, political, and educational groups during his career. In his retirement years, he spoke at national conferences in the United States and Mexico and led college students on cultural tours of Mexico. Calleros was active in many youth programs including the American Academy of Achievement, Crossroads of America, Boy Scouts, and Boys' Clubs.

He worked diligently for El Paso charities, especially the Mexican Division of the Community Chest and the United Fund. He was a board member and director for various Catholic orphanages and homes in El Paso. During the Depression years, Calleros served on the El Paso County Relief Board and on the Mexican Problems Committee of the Texas State Relief Commission. In 1934 he organized the Mexican and American Immigration Convention and *Sociedades Latino Americanas* in El Paso to fight discrimination and inequality. He edited *Actualidad*, a newspaper published by *Sociedades Latino Americanas*, which aimed at uniting the El Paso Mexican community against discrimination. In 1936, he successfully led the fight against color classification of Mexicans by county, state, and federal authorities in the United States.

As a leading member of the community, Calleros served on several El Paso Grand Juries from 1929 to 1961. He was named to the El Paso Health Commission and the El Paso Slum Clearance Commission in the 1930s. He was Chairman of the Street Name Change Committee in 1957 and a member of the El Paso County Historical Survey Commission in 1959. He worked on the Trans-Pecos Overland and Butterfield Stage Coach Centennials, from 1952 to 1959.

Calleros was founder or co-founder of many civic organizations. He was a board member of numerous Historical societies, museums, and libraries in El Paso, Ciudad Juárez, and vicinity. He was one of the founders of the El Paso County Historical Society and served on the board of directors of the El Paso Museum of Art and the El Paso County Library Board. He worked on the design of the Coat of Arms emblem for the city of Juárez, Mexico. He was a charter member of the Knights of Columbus, the Catholic Welfare Association, and many other local and national Catholic groups. He was also a charter member of various veterans' groups, such as the American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars, and other fraternal organizations.

Although he never ran for political office, Calleros was active in many political causes. He fought all of his life for equal rights and respect for people of Mexican descent. He was a strong friend and supporter of Raymond Telles, who became El Paso mayor and later the U.S. Ambassador to Costa Rica. He also supported the presidential campaign of John F. Kennedy. Calleros worked hard

to help bring about the Chamizal Settlement and was awarded the Chamizal Commemorative Silver Medal by President Johnson in 1965.

For his efforts on their behalf, the Tigua Indians in El Paso named Calleros an Honorary Adelantado in 1932. He worked to gain recognition for the Tiguas by writing their history and publicizing their heritage. He accompanied a group of Tiguas to the Texas Centennial Celebration at the Cotton Bowl in Dallas, Texas, in 1936, where they had a role in the festivities and made President Franklin D. Roosevelt an honorary Tigua Cacique.

Cleofás Calleros gained numerous honorary distinctions and recognitions throughout his career. The Spanish government made him a Knight of the Order of Isabela the Catholic in 1954 to recognize his efforts in matters related to the history of the Spanish in the Southwest. For his work with the Knights of Columbus, he was honored with the papal title of Knight of St. Gregory in 1961. In 1963, the Archbishop of Mexico awarded him the Rose of Our Lady of Guadalupe. He was inducted into the American Academy of Achievement and into the Gallery of Living Catholic Authors. In 1966, the International Institute of Arts and Letters of Switzerland appointed Calleros as a Life Member. He received several Certificates of Merit and “Conquistador” awards from the City of El Paso and honors from the State of Texas for his civic and historical work. He was listed in “Who’s Who in Texas” and “Who’s Who in the Southwest” among other honors. Cleofás Calleros died of natural causes in 1973. He was buried with military honors at the Ft. Bliss National Cemetery in El Paso, Texas.

Series Description

The Cleofás Calleros Papers are arranged in eight series:

Series I. General Correspondence

Arranged in four subseries—Incoming Correspondence, Outgoing Correspondence, Other General Correspondence, and Invitations and Announcements. Each subseries is arranged chronologically.

Series II. Civic/Religious Organizations and Activities

Arranged in twenty subseries—Incoming Correspondence, Outgoing Correspondence, Other Correspondence, National Catholic Welfare Conference Material, Texas Relief Commission, El Paso County Relief Board, Mexican and American Immigration Convention, Las Sociedades Latino Americanas, Color Classification of Mexicans, American Academy of Achievement, Knights of Columbus, Other Fraternal Organizations, Veterans’ Groups, Other Religious Organizations and Activities, Charitable Organizations, Youth Projects, Schools and Education, Historical Societies, Museums and Libraries, Butterfield Overland

Mail, Other Civic Organizations and Activities, Programs, and Other Materials. Material in each subseries is filed by topic or subject, and then chronologically.

Series III. Political Activities and Issues

Arranged in five subseries—Incoming Correspondence, Outgoing Correspondence, Other Correspondence, Other Political Material, and El Chamizal Dispute. Items in the subseries are filed chronologically.

Series IV. Business and Financial Materials

Arranged in twelve subseries—Incoming Correspondence, Outgoing Correspondence, Railroads, U.S. Army, WWI, Correspondence, Notary Public and Public Accountant Material, Calleros' Personal Finances, Insurance Material, Banks and Financial Institutions, Various Receipts, Other Business-Related Material, Business Clients, and Client Tax Returns. The subseries are filed by topic or subject, and then chronologically, except for Clients subseries that are filed alphabetically and then chronologically.

Series V. Literary Endeavors

Arranged in twelve subseries—Incoming Correspondence, Outgoing Correspondence, Other Literary Correspondence, Published Works—Books, Newspaper Articles by Calleros, Other Works by Calleros, Speeches and Addresses, Proofs and Drafts, Book Production and Promotion, Reviews and Critiques, Other Literary Endeavors, and Historical Research. Correspondence subseries are filed chronologically, and the other subseries are filed alphabetically by topic or subject.

Series VI. Personal and Biographical Material

Arranged in four subseries—Travel Memorabilia, Diplomas and Awards, Other Personal and Biographical Material, and Scrapbooks. Subseries are filed by topic or subject, and then chronologically.

Series VII. Photographs and Other Works of Art

Arranged in fifteen subseries—Banquets and Receptions, Historical, Other Civic Events, Churches and Clergy, Mt. Cristo Rey Construction, Tigua Indians and Ysleta Mission, Literary Endeavors and Book Presentations, Artistic, Maps, Documents, and Drawings, Calleros' Personal Photographs, Slides, Notes and Correspondence Relating to Photographic Descriptions, Postcards, Photograph Albums, and Negatives. Photographs are filed by subject and date, and then numbered chronologically in each folder. The numbers of negatives are matched

to the corresponding photographic print, if available. Negatives without matching prints are scanned, and paper prints of those negatives are filed with the photographs.

Series VIII. Publications by Others

Arranged in ten subseries—Books, Newspapers, Newsletters, Mexican American and Chicano Periodicals and Journals, Other Periodicals and Journals, Publications About El Paso, Juárez, and Southwest, Government Publications, Religious Publications, Other Mexican American and Chicano Publications, and Other General Publications. Each subseries is filed by type of publication, by title, and then by date.

Scope and Content Notes

The Cleofás Calleros Papers reflect the diverse interests and talents of this famous El Paso civic leader and Southwest historian, and his involvement with numerous civic, religious, and business organizations and institutions from about 1915 through 1973. His papers as Director of the local office of the National Catholic Welfare Conference document the role of the Catholic Church in immigration and social work on the U.S. – Mexican border. He assisted numerous religious orders expelled from Mexico during the post-revolutionary government's persecution of the Church in the 1920's and 1930's, as well as individual immigration and naturalization cases. Included in his papers are the minutes and correspondence from conferences of various local Mexican American political groups of the 1930's that fought for respect and equal rights for Mexicans, such as Sociedades Latino Americanas. Correspondence, yearbooks, scrapbooks and photographs of predominantly Mexican Catholic parishes chronicle the history of El Paso's Mexican American community from the 1920's to the 1960's. The activities of the Bishop and Diocese of El Paso, the Knights of Columbus, El Paso County Relief Board, and early veterans' groups, civic groups, charities, orphanages, and schools are related through his correspondence and photograph collection. The Chamizal Settlement is recorded in Calleros' correspondence and collection of newspaper articles about the dispute. The papers from his extensive business interests reflect the affairs of the local Mexican American community. Calleros' local history columns in the *El Paso Times*, copies of his publications, and historical research are included in this series as well. Many of the newspapers, newsletters, journals and pamphlets in the Calleros Papers relate to historical events in El Paso, Juárez and the Southwest. The Calleros Papers contain postcards from the Southwest United States and Europe. Rare photographs of Catholic missions and clergy, early religious processions, the construction of Mt. Cristo Rey, Mexican-American parish activities, the Tigua Indians, and historical photographs of early El Paso families and events are also part of the collection.

The first series, **General Correspondence**, contains Calleros' general correspondence; his World War I correspondence; correspondence written by Benita Blanco Calleros, various family members, and others; thank you cards, notes, invitations and announcements.

The **Civic/Religious Organizations and Activities** series includes files from the El Paso office of the National Catholic Welfare Conference. The office correspondence of Miss Caroline Boone, social worker and predecessor to Cleofás Calleros, is in this series, as well as Calleros' office correspondence. Government legislation and rules and regulations on immigration and naturalization are in this series. Files of religious groups expelled from Mexico and other immigration cases are in the Client Case Files.

Correspondence, minutes, and other materials relating to the activities of the Texas Relief Commission's Mexican Problems Committee and the El Paso Country Relief Board during the Great Depression are included. The papers from various El Paso Mexican American political groups from the 1930's are in this series, including the Mexican American Immigration Convention, Sociedades Latino Americanas, and materials relating to the color classification of Mexicans.

This series also reflects Cleofás Calleros' varied civic and religious activities. Correspondence, newspaper clippings, yearbooks and other materials from groups such as veterans' groups, fraternal organizations, youth projects, charitable organizations, historical societies, libraries, and museums are located here. Most notable and extensive are the papers of the Knights of Columbus, the American Academy of Achievement, local veterans' groups, Crossroads of America, Butterfield Overland Mail, El Paso Street Name Change Committee, Sun Carnival, and the Texas Centennial of 1936. A collection of local concert and theater programs from the 1920's and 1930's is included in this series.

The third series, **Political Activities and Issues**, has a large collection of newspaper articles and correspondence about the Chamizal Dispute, as well as correspondence with politicians and dignitaries and political campaign advertisements.

The next series, **Business and Financial Material**, reflects Cleofás Calleros' diverse business interests. His general business correspondence, statements and receipts from various individuals and local companies are included. Material from his job on the railroad contains correspondence and reports from various railways such as the Santa Fe and Southern Pacific Railroads. Legal contracts, deeds, mortgages, promissory notes, bills of sale, insurance policies, tax receipts, and banking records are in this series. Records and papers from his notary, accounting, income tax, and real estate businesses are filed in client case files.

Material related to Calleros' **Literary Endeavors** are contained in the fifth series. His literary correspondence and "El Paso—Then and Now" newspaper columns are included. This series contains drafts of some of his speeches, as well as promotional material and account ledgers for the sale of his books. His historical research, proofs and drafts, and publications of articles, pamphlets, and books are filed in this series. Newspaper clippings about his publications and his personal book collection are also included.

The sixth series, **Personal and Biographical Material**, contains travel memorabilia from the Calleros' many travels, especially to Europe in the 1920's and to Mexico. Many of Calleros' diplomas and awards, such as certificates from the Knights of Columbus and City of El Paso, are located in this series. His resume, personal recommendations, genealogy, marriage license, last will and testament, and other personal information are included. This series contains several newspaper clippings about Calleros. The scrapbooks include three Knights of Columbus books with photographs, clippings, and other memorabilia from about 1930 to 1940. Another scrapbook is on St. Ignatius Church and School from 1911 – 1933. A large scrapbook, titled "The Derricks," contains photographs, clippings, and souvenirs of early El Paso with notes in Russian. Also included in this series are two scrapbooks containing photographs and other materials from the visit of the Spanish Ambassador to El Paso in 1957.

A large assortment of over 2400 photographs and about 1400 negatives make up the seventh series, **Photographs and Other Works of Art**. Historical photographs include events and people in Paso del Norte, early religious processions, churches and clergy, civic events such as the Sun Carnival parade in 1936, and the Butterfield Overland Mail celebration in the 1950's. Other important photographs chronicle El Paso's Mexican American community, the construction of Mt. Cristo Rey, and various Tigua Indian gatherings at Ysleta Mission. The collection also contains photographs of banquets, book presentations, artistic photographs, and photographs of Calleros' travels, friends, and family. The series includes photographs of artist José Cisneros and illustrations he made for Calleros' books. Maps, photographs of historical documents, and other drawings are included. Over 350 postcards of Europe and the Southwestern United States and Mexico dating from 1920 to 1970, 48 slides of New Mexican missions, and an early album of western travel scenes are also in the series.

The last series, **Publications by Others**, contains books, local English and Spanish language newspapers (mostly articles and partial issues) and newsletters from El Paso civic and religious groups. Newspaper supplements from 1937 feature the coronation of King George of the United Kingdom. Some Mexican American and Chicano periodicals and other publications are in this series. A large assortment of articles and pamphlets from the early 1920's to 1970 describes points of interest in the local El Paso and Juárez areas. This series contains "El Jacal," St. Joséph's Academy Yearbook from 1940, and "La

Acequia,” the El Paso County School Annual from 1924. Other government, religious and general publications are located in this series.

Provenance Statement

The Cleofás Calleros Papers were donated to the C. L. Sonnichsen Special Collections Department of the University of Texas at El Paso Library in 1979 by Calleros’ daughter, Margarita Calleros Blanco, and his grandson, Raul C. Blanco. The collection is the result of the accession of 52 boxes. However, one box was returned to Margarita Blanco. Nine more boxes containing Calleros’ scrapbooks, albums, and published material were added to the collection later. The original accession number was 933, and the collection number changed to MS 231 in 1993.

Restrictions

Client Case Files and Reports in the National Catholic Welfare Conference material are restricted. Income tax returns and the files of Calleros’ business clients are also restricted. Photocopying of client photographs, tax returns, case files, reports, and any material with personal client information such as birth, baptismal, or marriage certificates is not allowed.
