

# The University of Texas at El Paso School of Nursing - Clinical Compliance Office RN to BSN Clinical Compliance Requirements

### Purpose:

A component of the RN to BSN Program and our collaborating clinical partner sites call for each participating student to satisfy a number of clinical requirements during the program's final semester cycles. These clinical requirements involve the submission of nursing credentials and vaccine records that most nurses will already possess. Students will submit these documents, digitally, within a contracted secure third party website. Should you have any questions or concerns about the obligation to satisfy these requirements, correspond with the RN to BSN Program Director. Students will provide and periodically update records for the following categories:

#### **Immunization Records:**

"Positive" Titer results or proper vaccine data are required for the following immunization categories:

- 1. Hepatitis B (HBV)
- 2. Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR)
- 3. Varicella (Chickenpox)
- 4. Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (TDap / Td).
- 5. Annual Influenza vaccine.
- 6. Annual TB Testing.

#### Miscellaneous Records:

Students will provide documents for the following categories:

- 1. Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). American Heart Association Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers.
- 2. Community Wide Orientation (CWO).

### **Drug Screening:**

1. All nursing students must submit to a 10-Panel Drug Screen. The current 3<sup>rd</sup> party compliance data tracking website will assist with drug screen scheduling. This process does not allow students to schedule their own independent drug screening appointments. Students receive drug-screening instructions upon activating their compliance account. The designated drug-screening lab will directly transmit the screening results to the current records management system.

### Criminal Background Check (CBC):

1. All RN to BSN Program students must submit to a CBC event. Previous or current employment CBC records will not satisfy this requirement.

### Costs:

Nursing students are responsible for their individual clinical compliance costs.


