Traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing

Transfer Students are required to have at least a 3.00 Overall GPA from the previous institution(s) to declare Nursing as a major at UTEP.

- Transfer students that do not meet the 3.00 Overall GPA requirement may select any other major temporarily at UTEP.
- It is recommended to select a major that the student is interested in while establishing the required Overall GPA. Choose a major that works with your career goals if you decide not to pursue nursing.
- The transfer student will be advised toward the selected major on record. Students interested in changing their major to nursing once their Overall GPA is at least 3.00 may schedule and attend an information/advising session with the College of Nursing by calling the phone number below. Non-nursing majors are welcome to attend the information/advising sessions.
- Financial Aid eligibility will only be for courses that contribute to the student's degree plan.
- Once the student establishes an Overall GPA of at least 3.00, the student will be eligible to officially change their major into nursing.
