



# 2023 GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Texas Pharmacy Foundation (TPF) offers an annual scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to a student pursuing a career in pharmacy at each accredited Texas school or college of pharmacy.

## Eligibility Criteria

Pharmacy students entering their second (P2), third (P3) or fourth (P4) professional year in the fall of 2023 with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0 in required courses are eligible. In addition, the applicant must be a student member of the Texas Pharmacy Association. Selection will be based on financial need and the potential to become a leader for Texas pharmacy, as demonstrated by involvement in pharmacy school and community activities.
