# Post test Question Sample

Question 1:

True or False: A pharmacist may be liable for civil and criminal penalties for refusing to dispense an opioid prescription that is written for more than a 10-day supply of an opioid drug.

Answer: False

Rationale: The law precludes liability for pharmacists whether or not they fill or refuse to fill the prescription: “(d) A dispenser is not subject to criminal, civil, or administrative penalties for dispensing or refusing to dispense a controlled substance under a prescription that exceeds the limits provided by Subsection (b).”
