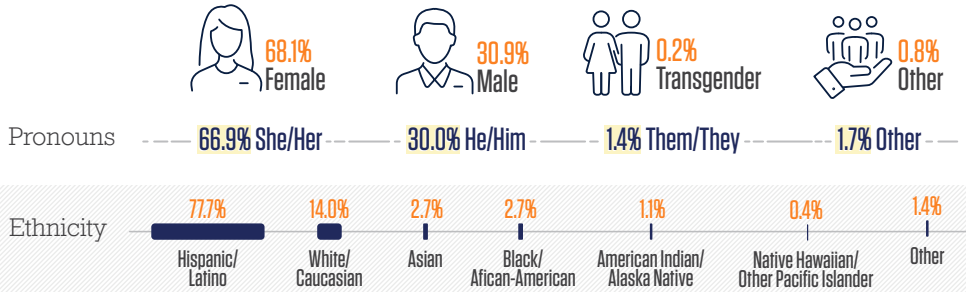

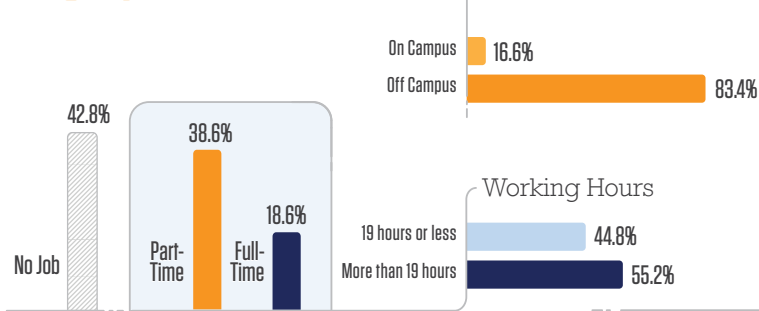

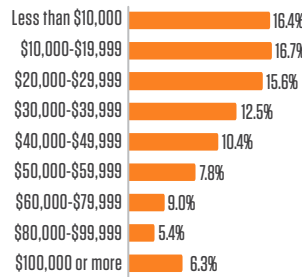

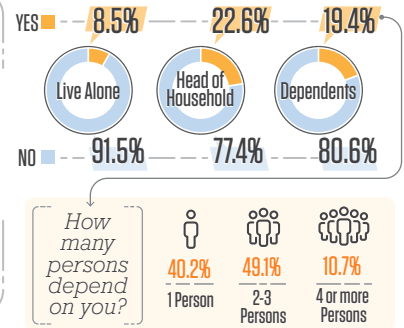
Employment Status



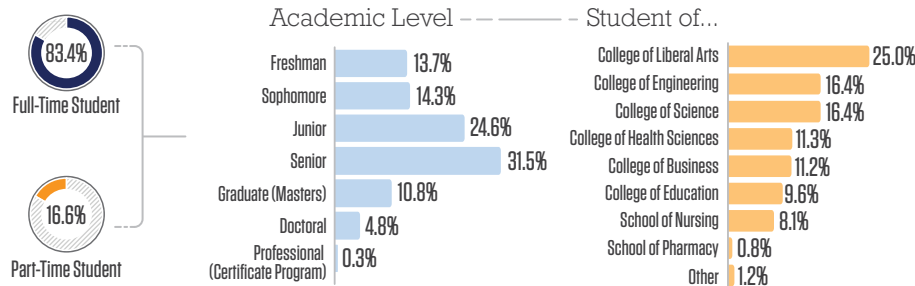
Total Household Income, 2019



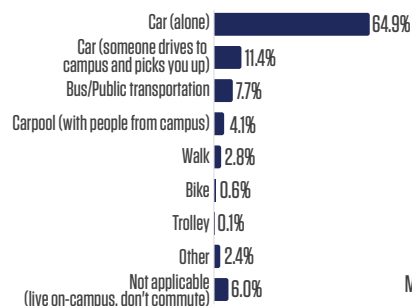

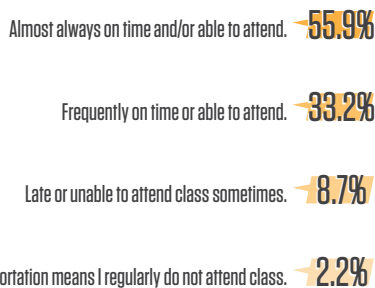

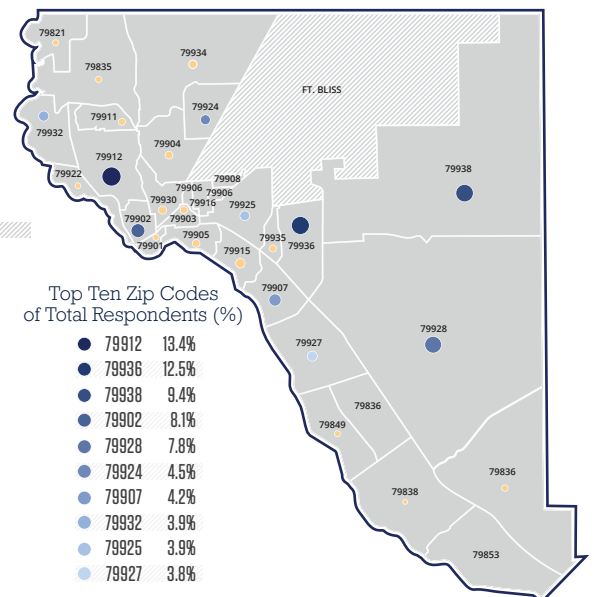

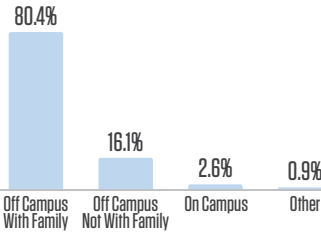

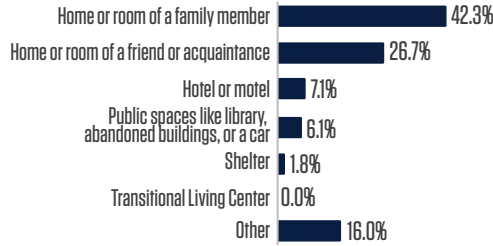

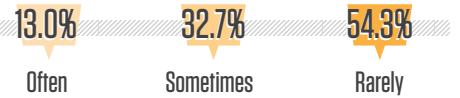
Where do you live?



Options to Spend a Night without a Permanent Address:



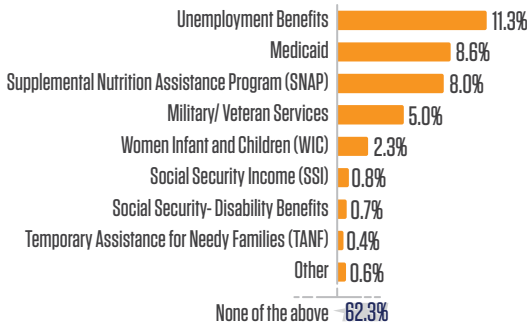
Frequently spent the night elsewhere in the past six months without permanent housing options:



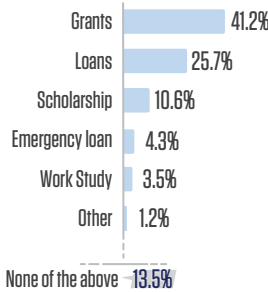
19.1% of UTEP student participants have experienced homelessness.

In the last 12 months "I couldn't afford to eat balanced meals."

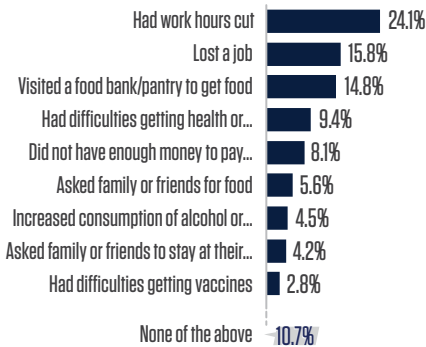


33.5% of student participants ate less because they did not have enough money for food.

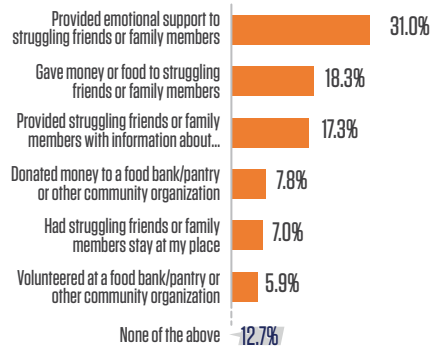
25.4% of student participants didn't eat because they did not have enough money for food.
