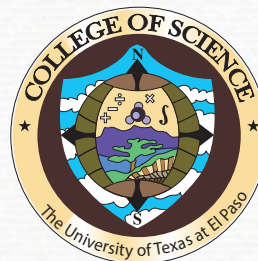

We are announcing the opening of the application period for the Bristol / Mayberry Award. This award was established in 2001 by Dr. Russell Broaddus, a 1987 microbiology graduate of UTEP, in honor of Dr. Jack Bristol, UTEP Professor Emeritus of Biological Sciences, and Dr. Lillian Mayberry, Research Professor of Biological Sciences. Applicants must be currently pursuing one of the majors offered by the Department of Biological Sciences, have completed 60 or more undergraduate hours, and must demonstrate outstanding scholastic or research achievement. To be considered for this round of the award, applicants must fill-out and submit the application provided below by 5:00 PM on Friday, January 18, 2013. The selection process will be performed by the Awards Committee of the Department of Biological Sciences. Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by January 25, 2013. The funds provided by this award will vary depending on the number and quality of the applicant pool, and can be used toward tuition fees, to help cover the costs associated to travel expenses to a scientific meeting, or to help cover costs associated to research being executed by the student within one of the laboratories of the Department of Biological Sciences. We encourage you to disseminate the word about this award and stimulate participation by your students.
