Woody L. Hunt College of Business

The college is among fewer than 5% of business schools accredited by AACSB. Four corporate academies prepare students with real-world knowledge: Banking, Risk Management, Human Capital Management, and more.

College of Education

Students who take state teacher certification exams pass 99% of the time. School districts from across the nation recruit UTEP graduates, who play a crucial role in transforming lives and unleashing the potential of future generations.

College of Engineering

Firsthand research experience accompanies a solid academic foundation from the classroom.

Students graduate ready for a lucrative engineering career. Expert faculty support seven academic departments and 15 state-of-the-art laboratories and research centers.

College of Health Sciences

There are 17 research centers, clinics, and laboratories allowing students to find answers across various fields: physical therapy, metabolism, rehabilitative care for speech and hearing, AIDS, and more.

College of Liberal Arts

Five centers and institutes make up the home of the social sciences, humanities, and visual and performing arts at UTEP, including the Center for Arts Entrepreneurship, the Center for Inter-American and Border Studies, the Center for Law and Human Behavior, the National Security Studies Institute, and the Law School Preparation Institute.

College of Nursing

UTEP students pass the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) for registered nurses at a rate of 96% compared to the national average of 86%.

School of Pharmacy

Prepare to serve diverse patients as a community pharmacist. UTEP's pharmacy program teaches Spanish proficiency and cultural sensitivity for future pharmacists to serve the U.S.-Mexico border region and beyond.

College of Science

The college has degree paths for in-demand fields, including forensic science, bioinformatics, environmental science, and resource sciences. The Medical Professions Institute boasts a 90% medical school acceptance rate for those with competitive GPA and MCAT scores and 55% overall, beating both Texas and national averages.






Bhutan on the Border


