Internship & Part-Time Job Fair - Impact Report 2022


On **April 5, 2022,** The **University of Texas at El Paso** welcomed **64 local organizations** to the Internship and Part-Time Job Fair. The intention of this event is to promote better awareness among students of opportunities in the area, where they can gain experience and enhance their future employability upon graduation.

There were 596 student attendees, (590 UTEP students, 2 Alumni and 4 community members). From the 591 active students in Job Mine, below is the breakdown per college.
