



## DINNER ETIQUETTE SPRING 2020 IMPACT REPORT

This event held during the spring semester is designed to educate students on proper dining etiquette during a business meeting, dinner or interview. A formal five-course dinner is served and is accompanied by a professional presentation. This collaborative effort is a partnership with the Career Center and the Student Engagement & Leadership Center.

### ASSESSMENT RESULTS:

- 96%** of the participants understand the role that dining etiquette places in the job search and the world of work
- 99%** of the participants stated that, after attending the etiquette dinner, they felt more confident about participating in a job interview over dinner
- 95%** identified the proper attire for a professional dining experience
- 99%** identified appropriate table talk tactics
- 94%** understand topics to avoid during dinner conversations
