This event held during the spring semester is designed to educate students on proper dining etiquette during a business meeting, dinner or interview. A formal five-course dinner is served and is accompanied by a professional presentation. This collaborative effort is a partnership with the Career Center and the Student Engagement & Leadership Center.

ASSESSMENT RESULTS:

96% of the participants understand the role that dining etiquette places in the job search and the world of work

99% of the participants stated that, after attending the etiquette dinner, they felt more confident about participating in a job interview over dinner

95% identified the proper attire for a professional dining experience

99% identified appropriate table talk tactics

94% understand topics to avoid during dinner conversations
