



## SPRING 2024 IMPACT REPORT

The Miner Manners Mastering Dining Etiquette is designed to educate students on proper dining etiquette during a business meeting, dinner or interview. A formal five-course dinner is accompanied by a professional presentation.

**99.4%** of the participants stated that, after attending the etiquette dinner, they felt more confident about participating in a job interview over dinner

**98.7%** of the participants understand the role that dining etiquette places in the job search and the world of work

**96.2%** identified the proper attire for a professional dining experience

**99.3%** identified appropriate table talk tactics

**91.1%** understand topics to avoid during dinner conversations
