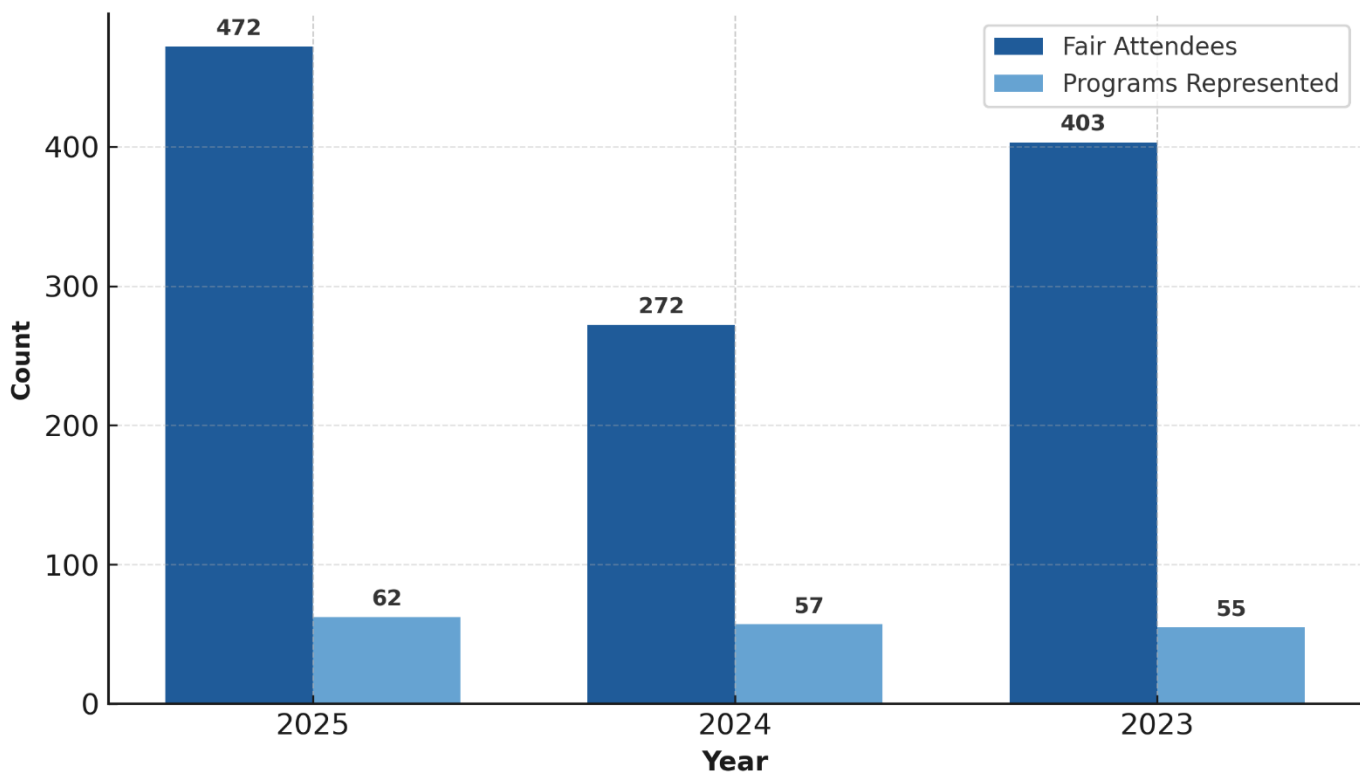
### Impact Report: In-person

On Tuesday, October 1, 2025, The University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) hosted an in-person event welcoming 62 graduate programs. The event introduced students to a range of post-baccalaureate study options, including UTEP programs from the Colleges of Education, Engineering, Business, Liberal Arts, and Graduate School. The fair showcased opportunities across health-related fields, law, and other graduate disciplines.

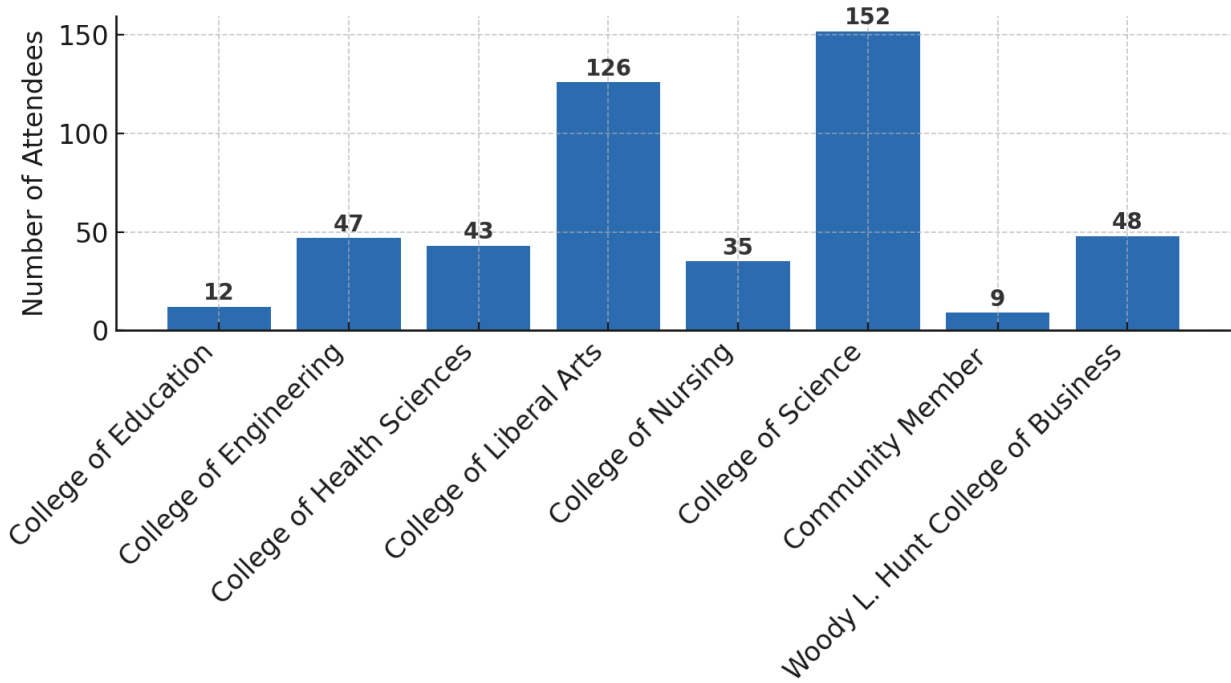
The event attracted 472 attendees, the majority of whom were freshmen, representing the largest group, followed by seniors. The College of Science had the highest student representation.

The 2025 fair marks the strongest engagement since 2003, with both attendance and program participation increasing compared to 2024. This growth reflects renewed the continued success of UTEP's efforts to connect students with graduate and professional education pathways.

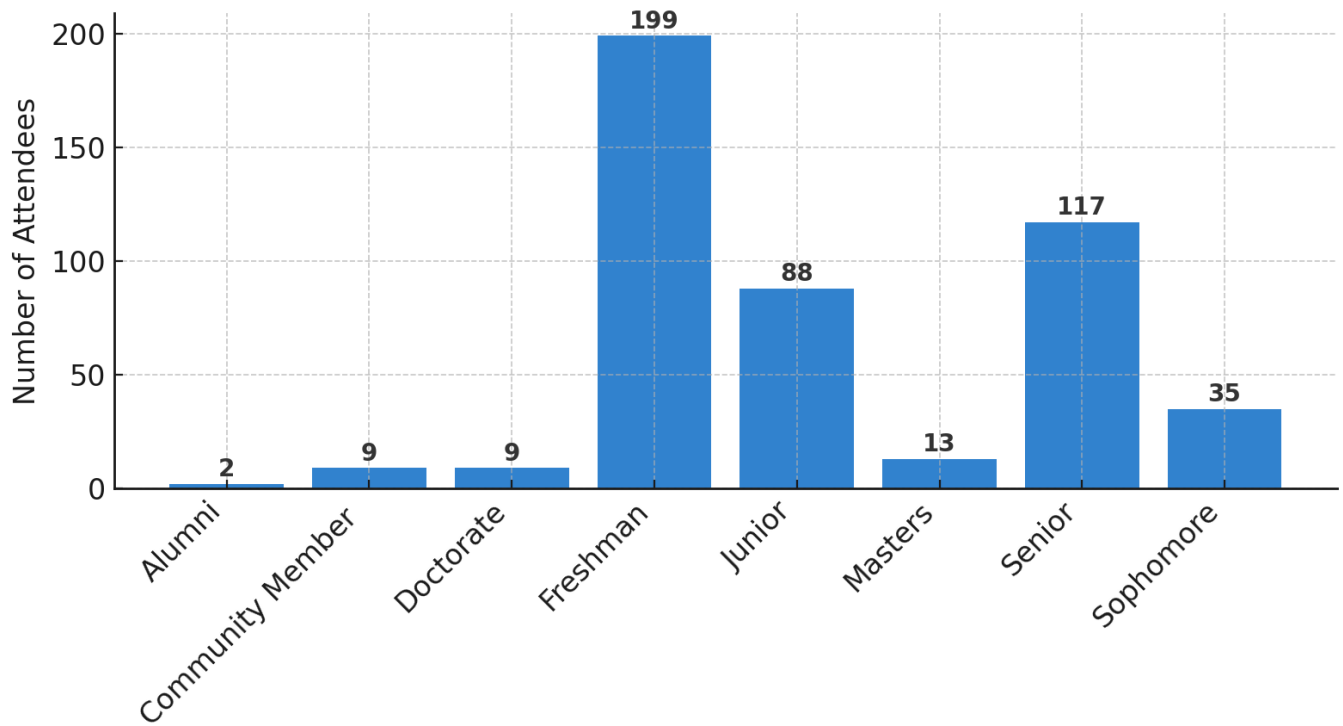
**UTEP Graduate & Professional Schools Fair (2023-2025)**



### COLLEGE PROFILE N = 472



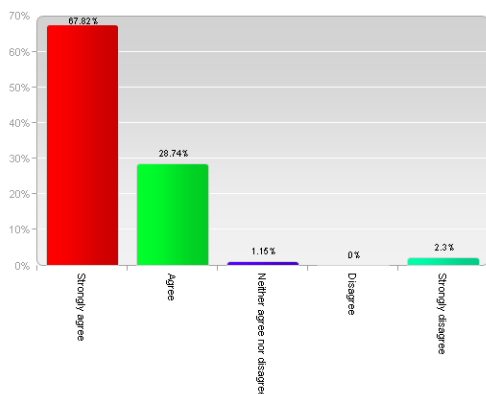
### CLASSIFICATION PROFILE n = 472



# Student Evaluation Responses

In a survey requested to fair participants, the event met its learning outcome goals of 80% or higher. Among the 89 respondents (19% response rate), at least 80% agreed or strongly agreed they would recommend the fair, found it very to extremely useful in their graduate search, and identified at least one institution offering a program in their intended field.

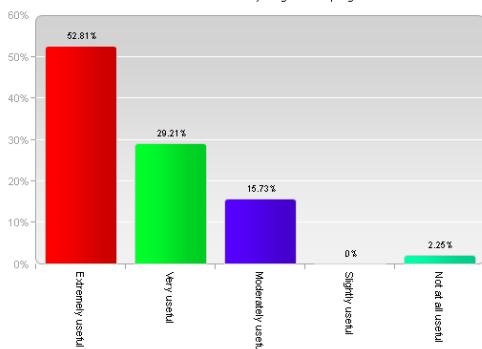
Q5. Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statements: - I would recommend this fair to others.

of students would agree to strongly agree in recommending the fair to other students.

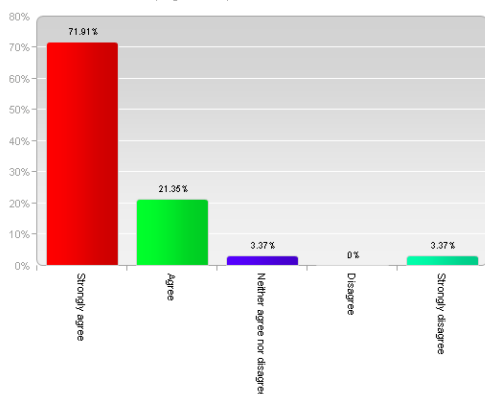
Q6. How useful was the fair in your graduate program search?

**93.26%**

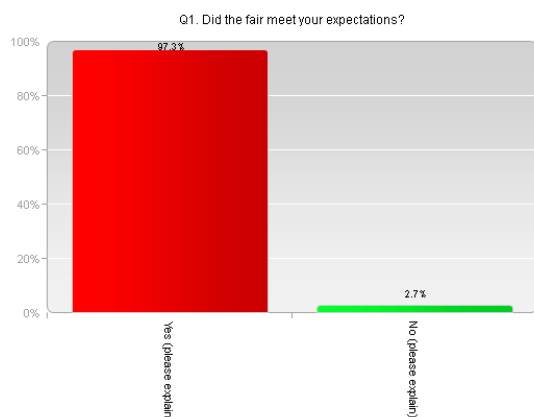

- "There were no art programs."

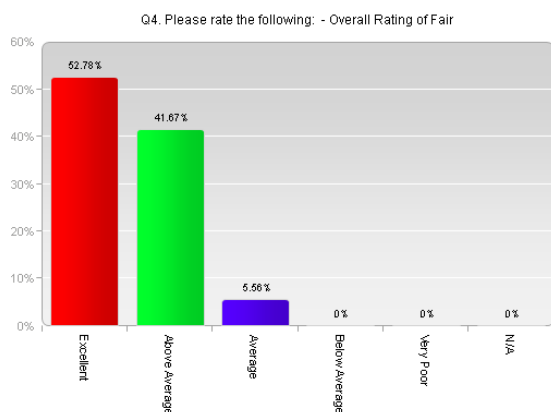
# Recruiter Evaluation Responses

In a survey distributed to recruiters, 36 respondents (58% response rate) provided the following feedback.



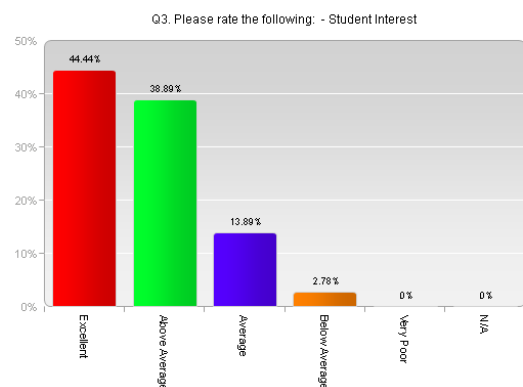
**97.3%**
