SWEET SUMMER

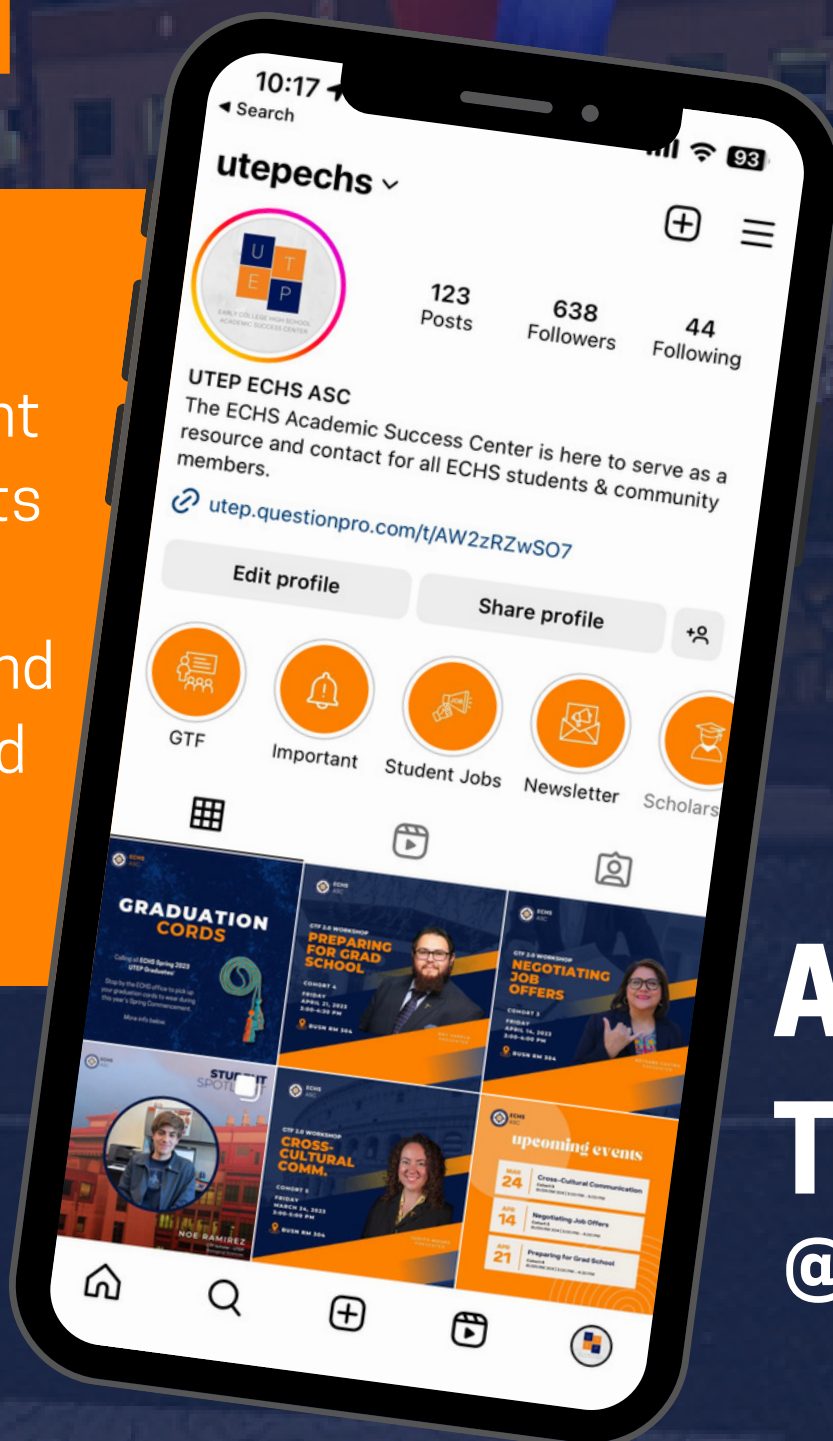

HISPANIC-SERVING INSTITUTIONS IMMERSION PROGRAM

The Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities, in partnership with Capital One, is offering 50 college students a four-day immersion program at the Capital One campus in Plano, Texas from July 24-27, 2023. This program provides selected students with opportunities for career exploration, professional development, and salary package negotiation. Capital One leaders will lead sessions on case interviews and business case studies. **Students who complete the program will be eligible for a \$1,000 stipend to support their academic studies.** The deadline to submit applications is June 5, 2023.

Eligible students must meet the following:

- Enrolled at a HACU-Member Hispanic-Serving Institution
- Rising sophomore, junior or senior with a GPA of 3.0 or above
- Business or technology related major
- Must be available to travel and participate in the immersion program from July 24-27, 2023
