# APPLYING TO UTEP

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Official or school-certified transcripts from all high schools and universities attended
- If students have the original documents, certified copies may be submitted initially at [submit@utep.edu](mailto:submit@utep.edu) (bold the email), with originals presented to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions upon arrival.
- Transcripts in languages other than English must include certified English translations.
- Apply Texas application
- \$65.00 application fee paid in U.S. dollars
- Satisfactory scores: SAT, ACT, PAA, TOEFL, Duolingo or Pearson Test of English (PTE).

**Graduate School:** Depending on the program, a statement of purpose, resume, or letter of recommendation are required for submission.

## TEST SCORE REQUIREMENTS

**Undergraduate**  
TOEFL: Internet-Based Test (iBT): 61  
Duolingo English Test (DET): Minimum score: 110

**Graduate**  
TOEFL: Internet-Based Test: 79

**NOTE:** Admission to certain majors is more competitive depending on the degree program and may require a higher GPA, test scores and additional criteria beyond general university admission requirements.

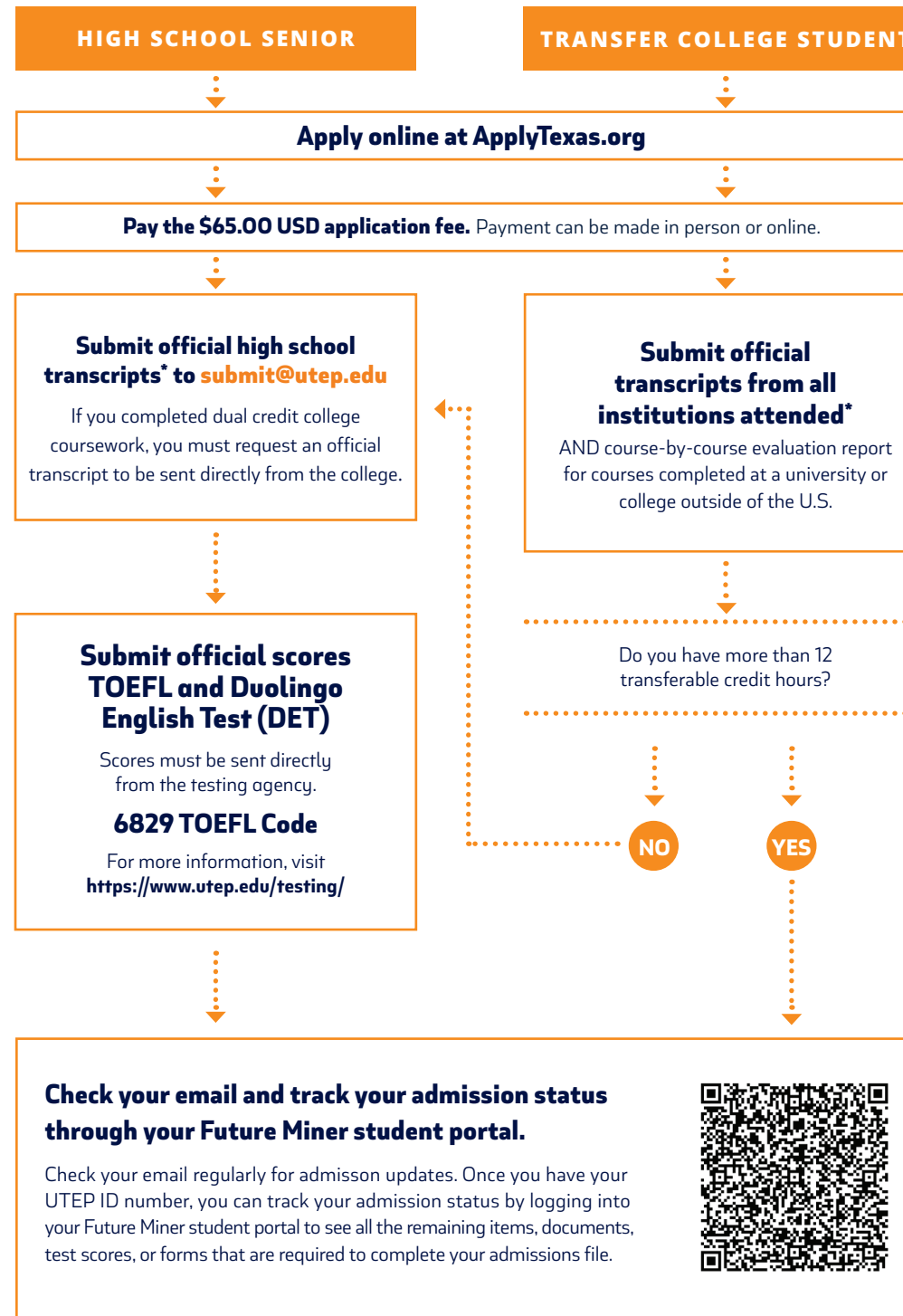
## INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION

- First-year Admission**
- A minimum 3.0 GPA (or B average)
  - Meet required test scores

- Transfer Admissions**
- A minimum 2.0 GPA (or C average)
  - Meet required test scores
  - Must be eligible to return to all previously attended institutions
  - All post-secondary schools must be listed in the application – failure to do so may result in denial or withdrawal of admission.
  - Students transferring from a U.S. college or university must notify their current International Student Advisor.

- Graduate Admissions**
- A minimum 3.0 GPA (or B average)
  - Meet required test scores

Students who completed university/college level courses at an institution outside the U.S. must complete a course-by-course evaluation from an approved evaluation organization. Scan to view approved Credential Evaluation Services

# PAYING FOR SCHOOL

## INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION

Financing your education often involves a combination of resources, including personal and family contributions, scholarships and fellowships. At UTEP, students are prepared for success and have the resources needed to confidently navigate the financial aspects of their college journey.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

We encourage you to visit the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships and the UTEP Global Center to discover institutional scholarships designed to support your academic journey. To be considered for academic scholarships, you must be an admitted UTEP student and submit the application by the scholarship deadline.

## College and Departmental Scholarships

Academic departments and colleges at UTEP also offer a range of scholarships, with varying award amounts and eligibility criteria. College-level scholarships are generally open to all students within the college who meet the specified requirements, while departmental scholarships are typically reserved for students majoring in specific disciplines.

## STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (PASE)

Receive in-state tuition rates at UTEP through PASE – a financial assistance program that grants eligible Mexican students a tuition discount, so they can pay the same tuition as Texas residents.
