Chair notes

Budget as of 12/1/2023

Bill 53 The committee settled to appropriate the amount of \$400.00 (forfeited) to Bill 53. The conference represents a unique opportunity for the student to dig deeper into her field of study and represent the institution internationally. The money appropriated should help with lodging expenses incurred.

- Bill 60 The committee settled to appropriate the amount of \$375.00 to Bill 60. The committee took an extra week to discuss the Bill amid changing circumstances with the budget. After further consideration, the committee wishes to help cover the registration fee expenses incurred by the student. This conference signifies a great opportunity for the student to network with peers in the industry and present his work.
- Bill 69 The committee settled to appropriate the amount of \$280.00 to Bill 69. Lodging seems to be the biggest burden for the student and the committee wants to help defray the expenses for this item. The suggested hotel is "Astor Crowne Plaza" through Booking.com. The amount should cover roughly 50% of lodging.
- Bill 71 The committee settled to appropriate the amount of \$1,000.00 to Bill 71. After much discussion, the committee wishes to appropriate \$50.00 per student (assuming 20 students make the trip) and that the UTEP Rugby Club spends at least the product of the amount appropriated per student and the number of students making the trip in lodging costs
- Bill 74 The committee settled to appropriate the amount of \$280.00 to Bill 74. Of the items shown in the Bill, the committee wishes to help the UTEP Rugby Club acquire the portable athletic trainer table, the Cramer athletic tape, and the Cramer tape pre-wrap. The amount appropriated should be sufficient to cover the cost of these three items.
